In addition, there are two junior ballrooms, sized at 5,300 and 6,100 square feet. To top it all off is Cobo's centerpiece: the Grand Riverview Ballroom.

Cobo's new 40,000-squarefoot by forty-foot-high Grand

Riverview Ballroom is stunning, and the dramatic three-story glass atrium features views of the Detroit River. The ballroom is equipped with state-of-the-art amenities and accoutrements such as a mechanically assisted stage lift, dynamic lighting and world-class banquet capabilities that can serve up to 2,400 people. It is supported by 10,000 square feet of pre-function space with floor-to-ceiling views of the Detroit River and the RiverWalk



promenade. Cobo Center also has a new 4,500-square-foot sound stage and video studio with full production services available on-site and satellite uplink capabilities. That's along with a robust, free Wi-Fi system and an in-house, centrally controlled communications system that includes programmable video displays outside every meeting room.

Thanks to a new labor agreement, doing business at Cobo Center is even better for the customers. The agreement brings onsite operations up to industry standards by streamlining work rules, improving exhibitor rights, reducing the cost of materials handling up to 30 percent and expanding straight-time pay periods.
